

L. A. Harbor College CNA/ CHHA Program Information, Requirements, and Approximate Costs

1. Submit an application for admission to Los Angeles Harbor College if you are not already a current student: (No application fee required): Apply to Los Angeles Harbor College online at:

2. Register for the CNA and/ or CHHA courses (see LAHC class schedule for section numbers)
3. Complete the Application Packet. (to be completed at orientation)
4. A complete physical examination. The form for this may be found in the application packet. This must be completed and signed, in all places indicated, by your health care practitioner (a licensed physician or certified Nurse Practitioner). The examination includes blood tests, urinalysis, and vaccinations as described on the form.
5. A Tuberculin Skin Test*, performed and read within the past six months. On a separate from the TB Skin Test should give the date it was done, the date it was read, whether it was positive or negative, and have the signature of the health care provider. A positive TB Skin Test requires a clear chest x-ray report.
6. A valid CPR provider card. This may be completed during the CNA course.
7. Students entering this program are expected to be able to read, write and communicate at the high school level in order to successfully complete the program.

*(NOTE: LAHC Students may receive free TB skin testing from College Nurse).

Please enroll in the college and the courses prior to the first day of class. You will receive the program application, physical examination forms and tests and any other required information at the Mandatory Program Orientation Day (date listed in current [class schedule](#)). This orientation is held in the Nursing Department in the Nursing Division Building at Los Angeles Harbor College.
