2. Demonstrate understanding of medication.			
3. <b>Determined compatibility with existing IV solution.</b> *			
4. Assessed patient's history of drug allergies.			
5. <b>Identify patient. Using 2 identifiers.</b> *			
6. Assessed patency and infusion rate of main IV.			
7. Performed hand hygiene.			
8. Explained purpose of medication and encouraged patient to report signs of discomfort at site			
9. Connected infusion tubing to medication bag and primed the tubing.(Back flow PRN)			
10. Hung medication and primary bag at proper level or with primary tubing via saline lock.			
11. Cleaned injection port.			
12. Connected tubing to appropriate port.
