

Nursing Program Approximate Costs

PREADMISSION: After being notified of your admission to the nursing program, and prior to the first day of class, the following requirements must be completed.

Background Check (required by clinical agencies): \$48.00 (subject to change)

Basic Life Support ("C" level) health care provider CPR course: \$35 to \$60

Basic First Aid Course: \$35 to \$60 (Not required of incoming LVN-RN students)

Physical Examination, including Lab work and infectious disease immunity titers: \$150 to \$350

Immunizations, including Hep-B: \$100 to \$350

* Increases in Tuition and Licensure Fees are proposed with each State budget. Expect these to increase.

Non-Residents from another state pay approximately \$193/unit and Foreign students pay approximately \$203/unit.

Students auditing a class currently pay \$15/unit.

Scholarship opportunities, offered by local health care agencies, are available for nursing students in good standing.

Limited funding for service to the program, Nursing Learning Lab, and peer tutoring may be available for nursing students in good standing.
