PACE (Program for Accelerated College Education) is a five semester curriculum on hand by Los Angeles Harbor College to meet the needs of working adults. There are four instructional tracks: two on-campus tracks, with an emphasis on Inter-Disciplinary Studies and Teaching; the off-campus Labor Studies Track; and, the on-line Business-Track. The program is designed to satisfy the lower division General Education requirements for California State Universities and the requirements for the Associate of Arts degree from L.A. Harbor College. Please talk to your L.A. Harbor College counselor for more information about transferring.

Courses are team taught in an inter-disciplinary environment. Classes meet one night per week from 5:45 p.m. to 10:15 p.m., as well as are six required all day and two half day Saturday conferences held on the campus each semester.

Internet assignments are also used to complement course content. Students will normally enroll in all four courses in a single group on the same evening.
