FREE PRIVATE LESSONS

Free private vocal and instrumental lessons are available to Harbor College Music Majors through our Applied Music program. A student who qualifies will receive weekly lessons for four semesters. The lessons are taught by the Music Department faculty and staff as well as by qualified local private teachers.

Requirements

1. File an Application Form in the Music Department office.
2. Play an audition for acceptance and placement in the program. Information regarding audition times will be posted on the S.T.A.R.S. bulletin board in the Music Building lobby. Choose 5-10 minutes of music to demonstrate your ability and background. An accompanist is available by appointment.
3. Enroll in a minimum of 12 units at Harbor College.
4. At least 6 units must be in courses required for one of the Music Major programs: Certificate, A.A. Degree or Transfer. (See ☆ Handouts #6-9.)
5. At least one (1/2) unit must be in a Performance Ensemble. (See ☆ Handout #12, Performance Enles.)
6. Enroll in Applied Music (Music 181-4) and maintain acceptable attendance and participation.
7. Enroll in Applied Music Lab (Music 180), the Private Lessons, after you have been assigned to a specific teacher's section. The one-half (1/2) unit for your lessons will count toward your total units.
8. Practice at least 5 hours in the Music Building every week of the semester. These hours bring State money to support the program.
9. Good attendance at lessons and classes, and grades of "C" or better in all Music courses is necessary for continued participation in the lesson program.
