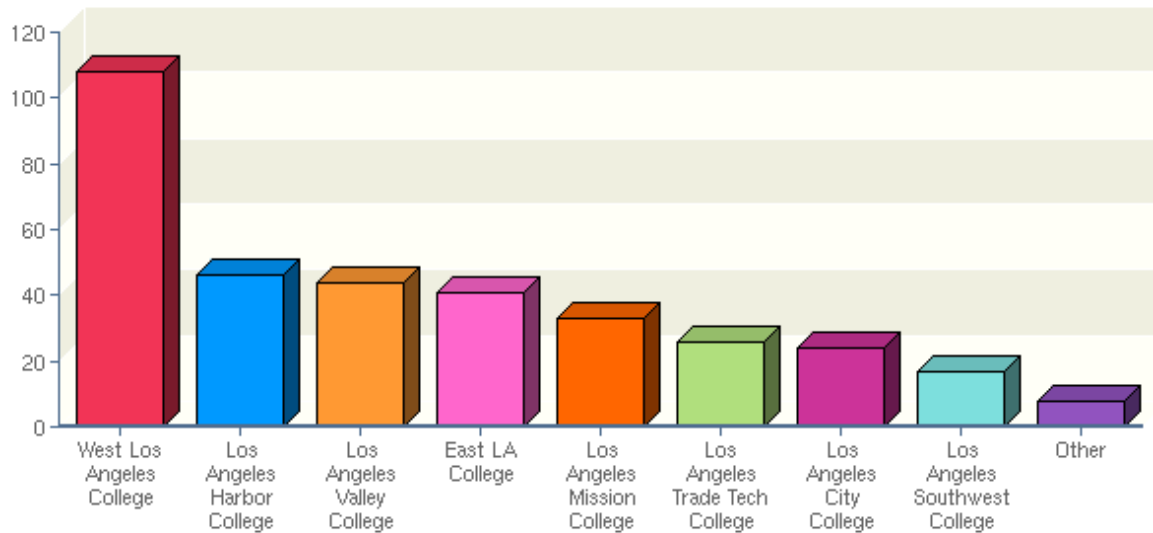

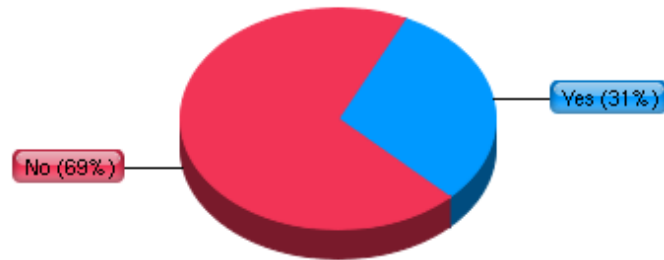
1. Select the college where you enrolled in the distance education course(s) that you dropped in the Fall 2008 term.

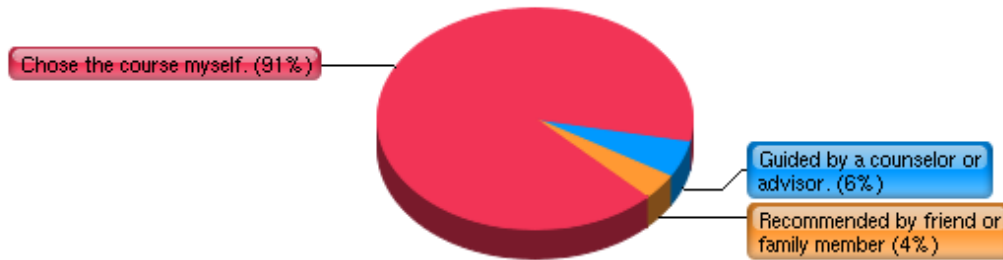
2. Was this your first experience with a distance education course?

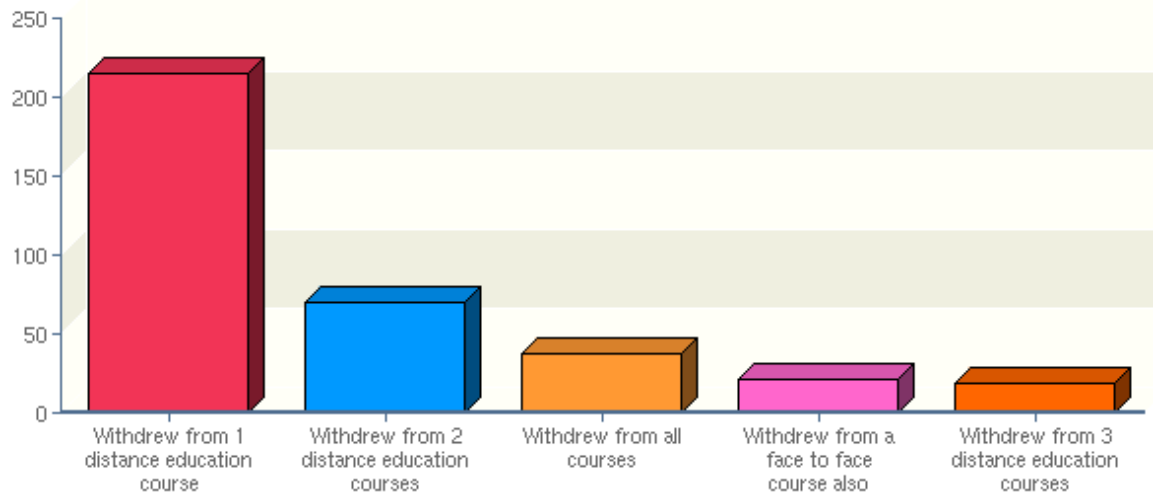
3. Did you choose to take this distance education course yourself, or was your choice guided by a counselor or advisor?

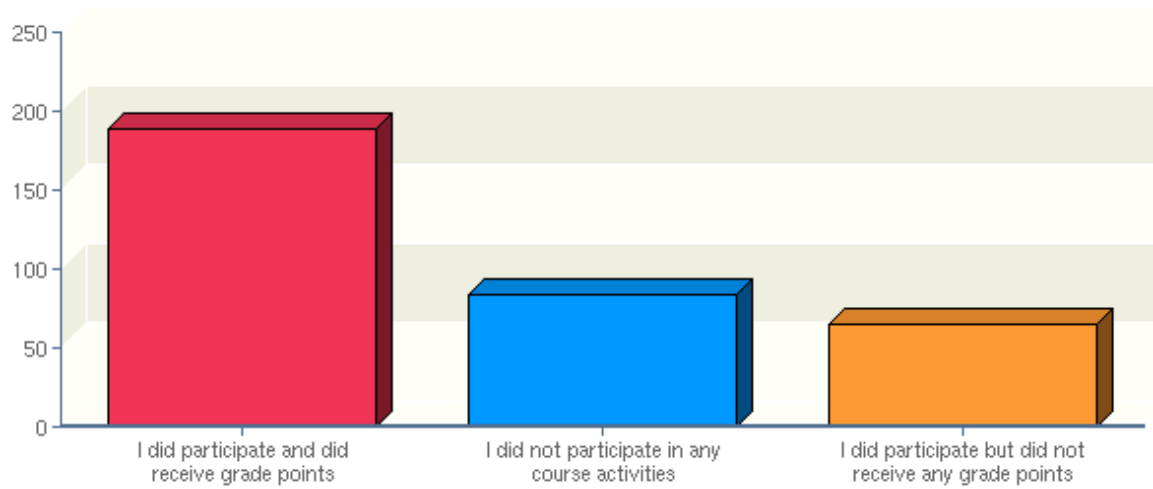
4. From how many courses did you withdraw in the Fall 2008 term? Select all that apply.

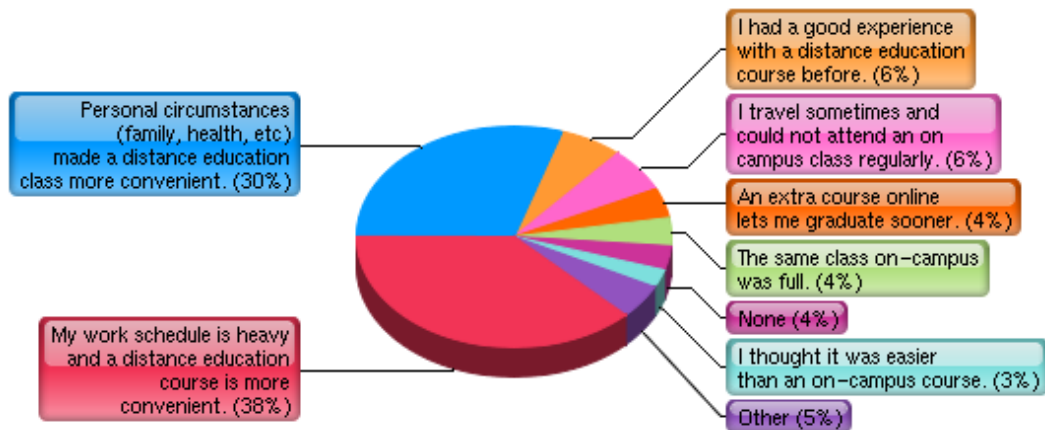

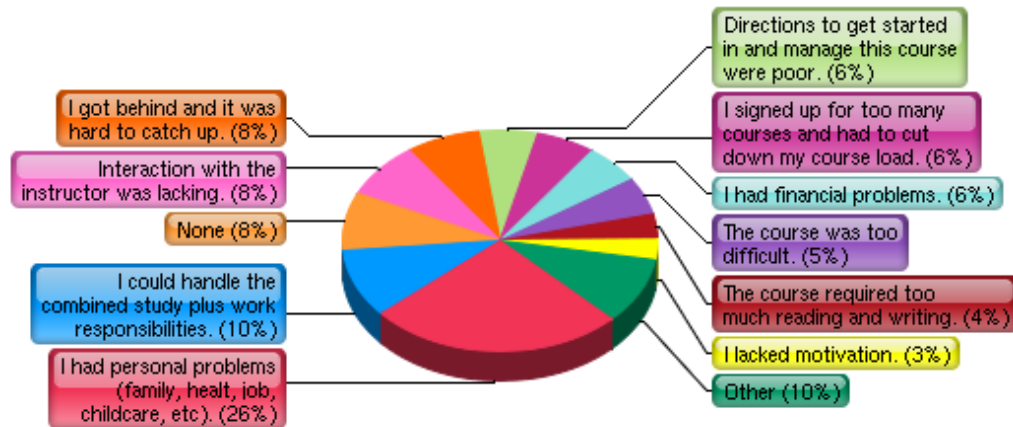

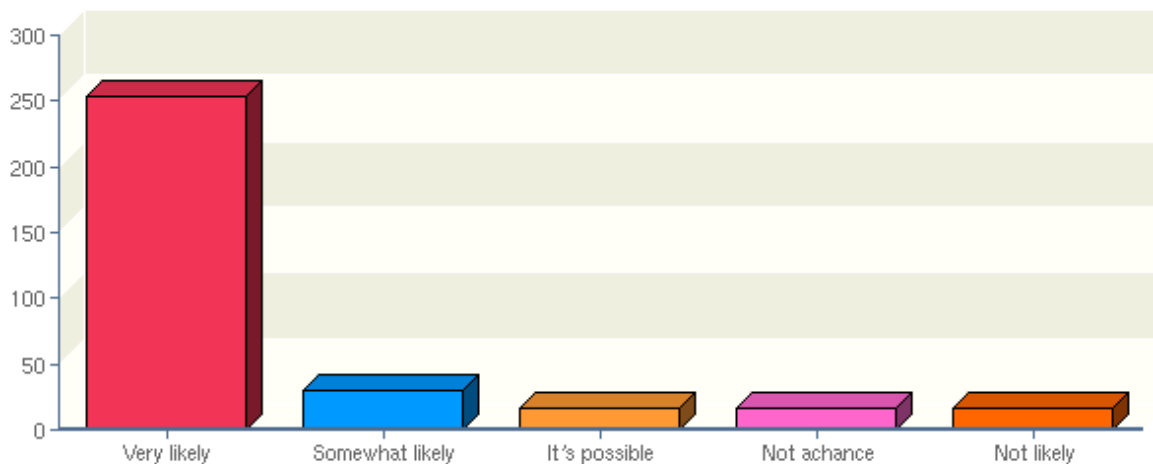
