The center for mental health, Life Skills Center (LSC), is dedicated to providing counseling and related services to LAHC students. The goal is to enable students to meet the personal, familial, and environmental challenges and pressures which can interfere with the ability to succeed academically and personally.

The LSC is staffed by a licensed clinical psychologist and advance graduate student interns from Masters and Doctoral level psychology programs in the Los Angeles area.

Life Skills Center is located in the Bungalow next to Special Programs and Services. Walk in hours are in the Student Health Center.
