

Student Learning Outcomes for Japanese Classes

JAPANESE 001 Elementary Japanese I

Speaking: By the end of Japanese 001, students will be able to exchange greetings, give their identity, and handle some simple communicative tasks by using memorized phrases. They are about to participate in basic conversations on topics related to school, home, and leisure activities.

Listening: By the end of Japanese 001, students will understand short conversational spoken narratives and simple descriptions with limited expressions on topics related to school, home, and leisure activities.

Reading: By the end of Japanese 001, students will recognize the letters and a limited number of characters. They will understand short conversational written narratives and simple descriptions on topics related to school, home, and leisure activities.

Writing: By the end of Japanese 001, students will supply limited information on simple forms and documents. They will also write short passages on familiar topics such as school, home, and leisure activities, using limited formulaic language.
