

NetTutor: Faculty & Staff Guide

What is NetTutor?

NetTutor is a 24-hour online tutoring platform the LACCD has subscribed to. Students can either meet online live with a tutor, drop off a paper which a tutor provides feedback for within 24 hours, or they can drop off a question and check for feedback later.

Math and the Writing/Paper Center specifically have live tutors available online 24 hours, and other subjects have slight limitations.

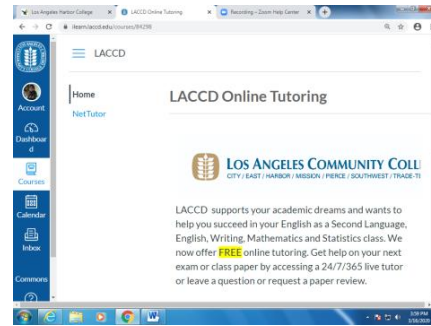
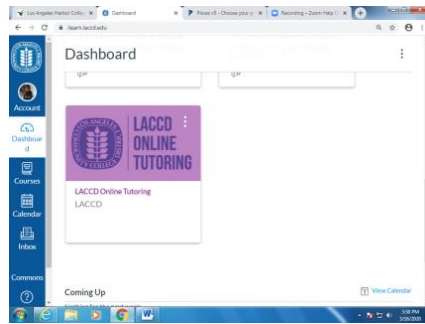
Does NetTutor provide confirmation of its use?

Students have a "locker" which records all their live tutoring sessions and keeps store of questions and papers they dropped off allowing for any confirmation students may need to provide to any instructor or student service.

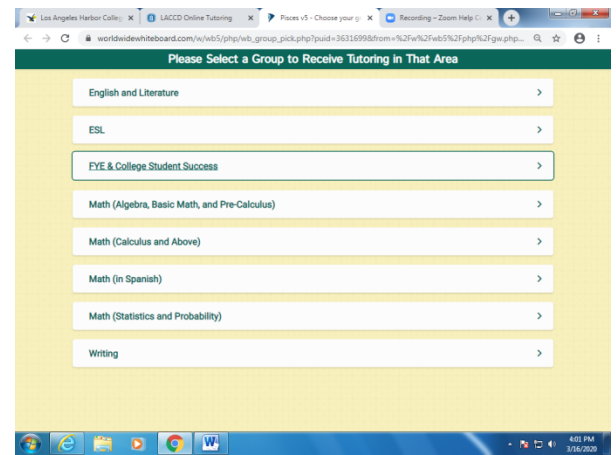
How is NetTutor available?

Students have access to NetTutor through their Dashboard (LACCD Online Tutoring) on Canvas and also within each class on the side menu. Please see the instructions below.

1. On your dashboard, click on LACCD Online Tutoring
2. Click on NetTutor. Agree to the terms.



3. Click the area of tutoring you need.



4. Choose to:

- Meet with a live tutor
- Drop off a question and check back later
- Drop off a paper (for the Writing/Paper Center)
