Eligibility to Apply

- **Anatomy 001, Physiology 001, and Microbiology 020** with a “C” or better and a combined **Science GPA of 2.5** or greater
- **English 101** with a “C” or better
- **Math 125** or placement in **transfer level math** or meet **math competency**
- **Psychology 001** and **Psychology 041** with a “C” or better
- **College-level Chemistry**, or one year of high school chemistry with a “C” or better
- **Cumulative GPA of 2.5** or greater
