- English 101 with a "C" or better
- Math 125 or placement in transfer level math or meet math competency
- Psychology 001 and Psychology 041 with a "C" or better
- College-level Chemistry, or one year of high school chemistry with a "C" or better
- Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or greater
