 - ► September 2022 → Spring 2023



Before we proceed...Highly Recommended

- Make an appointment with a counselor
 - Recommended to meet with counselor at your school, not required at LAHC
 - ► Review all coursework for eligibility



REQUIRED INFORMATION SESSIONS

- ► Applicants are required to attend a nursing program information session.
- Dates of information sessions will be available on the nursing website.
- ► Applicants will be emailed proof of attendance within one week of session, print email and include with application
 - ▶ Proof of attendance valid for one year from issue




Program Routes

Prerequisites: Sciences Requirements

- ► Grade of "C" or better
 - ► Applies to Lecture and Lab
 - For plus/minus grades, no "C-"
- Science GPA 2.5 or higher
 - ► All "C" grades do not equal 2.5
- Repeats: No more than ONE repeat in the sciences (not allowed once 2.5 gpa is reached)
- Currently no recency requirement

- ► All prerequisites must be completed prior to applying to the nursing program
- ▶ Grade of "C" or better
 - ► For plus/minus grades, no "C-"
- Cumulative GPA 2.5 or higher on all coursework
 - Whether or not applicable to nursing requirements
- Currently no recency requirement



Prerequisites: Requirements cont.

- Proof of education (choose highest applicable)
 - Graduation from a U.S. accredited high school or equivalent (e.g. GED) OR
 - Completion of AA or higher degree from a U.S. accredited college or university
 - Proof shown on official transcripts
 - ► Copies of diplomas or AA graduation petitions in progress will not be accepted
- Social Security Number (SSN) or Individual Tax Identification Number (ITIN)



Co-requisites

- Series of courses required for degree (A.S. Nursing, Professional)
- Highly recommended to be completed prior to applying to the nursing program
 - Beneficial for CSU transfer as well as point system for admission







Application: Transcripts

- ➤ You must submit transcripts from ALL institutions attended, whether or not related to pre/co-requisites
 - Including institutions listed on another institution's transcripts

Application: Transcripts within LACCD

- ► ONE (I) UN-official transcript
 - ▶ All LACCD coursework on one transcript
 - ▶ Include with Nursing Application Form
 - Not required to provide to LAHC Admissions and Records



Application: Transcripts outside of LACCD

- Order TWO (2) official transcripts
- ► Ist: Nursing Application
 - ▶ Do not mail separately to Nursing Department
- ▶ 2nd: LAHC Admission and Records
 - Must be sent directly from institution to LAHC Admissions
 - ► Mailed directly to Admissions; do not hand deliver



Application: Transcripts outside of LACCD cont.

- ► Foreign transcripts
 - Official sealed transcripts AND official sealed evaluation
 - ▶ Remember to petition courses for equivalency
- Out-of-state/Private Institution transcripts
 - ▶ Remember to petition courses for equivalency



Application: High School Transcripts

- High School transcripts: when to submit?
 - ▶ If you do not have a previous degree (AA or higher)
 - ▶ If you are using High School Chemistry (even with previous degree)
 - Example 1: High School graduate needs to submit high school transcripts
 - ► Example 2: Student with Bachelor's using high school chemistry needs to submit high school transcripts
- One copy with application, one copy mailed to Admissions
- Copies of diplomas will not be accepted

Application: Petitions

- ► See a counselor, at your school, to ensure your courses meet admission requirements
- ▶ If there is no current agreement or articulation of a course between one institution and LAHC, then a petition for course equivalency is required
 - www.assist.org is a great resource that you can start with on your own



Application: Petitions cont.

- Majority of community college courses do not require petitions
- ► Many university courses (CSU, UC) are accepted
- Petitions are absolutely required for courses used from
 - Out-of-state institutions
 - ► Any private institutions (e.g. Southern California University of Health Sciences)
 - **▶** Foreign institutions




Application: Petitions cont.

- Petition for course equivalency
 - See Counseling website for form
 - Usually include course grade, description, syllabi, etc.
- Submit to Admission and Records, not to individual departments
 - https://effectiveness.lahc.edu/student_services/admissions/SitePages/forms.aspx
- Signed off by department chair/administrator



Application: Petitions cont.

- Not a quick process (plan ahead)
- Must include copy of signed, approved petition OR posted on LAHC transcript (Memoranda)

Application: Transcripts cont.

- Advanced Placement (AP) Coursework
 - Credit may be granted immediately OR may require petition for credit – see a counselor
 - ► Send scores to Admissions & Records for credit
 - ▶ If not posted on transcripts must include copy of score report with application
 - ▶ Must provide LAHC unofficial transcript as proof

- ► Applicants will be emailed proof of attendance within one week of the information session to include with their application.
 - ▶ Please print your email and include with application
 - Proof of attendance valid for one year from issue



Application: Nursing Application Form cont.

- Submit application, transcripts, petitions to Nursing Building, dropped off in the mail drop OUTSIDE the Nursing division (you will not be allowed in the building)
 - ► Make sure all documents are together (e.g. envelopes)
 - Drop in book drop outside Nursing department
 - ▶ No one is allowed in the Nursing building

Application: What Happens Next?

- ► Applications are reviewed and processed AS-IS!
- ► Allow 6 to 8 weeks from submission deadline for evaluation process
- All transcripts and attachments become property of the college
- Initial review by Nursing department for apparent errors
- Coursework evaluated by Admissions and Records
 - Verify eligible coursework / calculate GPAs



Application: What Happens Next?

- Check student email (@student.laccd.edu) regularly
 - Status of eligibility will be sent via student email only
 - Know how to access and operate
 - Double check spelling of email, will not be corrected




Application: Denied?

- ► Incomplete application (READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS)
- Incorrect / misspelled e-mail
- No signature on form
- Missing Transcripts
- Incomplete petitions
- ► Low Science or cumulative GPA (<2.5)
- Too many attempts
- Application was not answered truthfully
- Failed TEAS previously
- ► Missing student I.D. number



Admission Process





- ► Applications have been reviewed for eligibility
- Initial correspondence of eligibility by student email
 - ► Eligible: No offers for admission yet, but rather to move forward in admission process
 - ▶ Ineligible: review message, consider to reapply
- ► Next step: ATI TEAS



ATITEAS: What is it?

- ► Test of Essential Academic Skills
- Standardized entrance exam used by this nursing program, covers knowledge in
 - ▶ Reading
 - Mathematics
 - Science
 - English/Language usage
- ▶ 170 questions, 209 minutes



ATITEAS: New Changes

- ► TEAS Version V is replaced by ATI TEAS starting August 31, 2016
- TEAS V scores no longer accepted as of June 2017—only ATI TEAS scores accepted
- Use of on-screen calculator for Mathematics



ATITEAS: Requirements

- ► Minimum requirement: 62% overall
 - ▶ To be replaced by new scoring metric, date TBD
- Only the first attempt accepted
 - ▶ If taken elsewhere and below 62%, applicant is ineligible to apply at LAHC, despite subsequent higher scores



ATITEAS: Selection

- ► Applicants who have previously taken the ATI TEAS will be instructed to have test results sent from the ATI website directly to "Los Angeles Harbor College"
- Only the first score is accepted
- Previous versions of the ATITEAS (e.g.TEAS V) will not be accepted



ATITEAS: Selection

- ▶ For those who have not taken the ATITEAS
 - ➤ 50% will be selected by the multi-criteria point system (highest points prior to ATITEAS will be selected)
 - ► In the event of a ranking tie that exceeds the number of vacancies, a random lottery will be conducted among those in that ranking
 - 50% of the applicants will be selected by random lottery

ATITEAS: Requirements cont.

- ▶ Do not include or send your scores until requested by the Nursing Department
- Scores sent before request by the department will NOT be used and must be re-ordered



ATITEAS: Invitation


- Check student email (@student.laccd.edu) regularly for invitations
- ► Must reply to invitation date(s) by deadline
- Computerized exam on campus at no cost
 - Contact department if accommodations are needed
- ▶ Not selected?
 - Reapply next application period



ATITEAS: Outcome

- Passed ATI TEAS: move forward to Selection
- ► Not Passed (with LAHC)
 - ► Eligible for remediation, as available
 - Individualized plan to improve weak areas
 - ▶ Given up to one year to complete
 - ▶ If satisfactory, given another chance to take TEAS
 - ► Achieve minimum score in ALL areas







Admission Process





Selection for Admission

- Points applied to admission criteria, applicants ranked
- ▶ 50% admitted by multi-criteria process
 - In the event of a ranking tie that exceeds the number of vacancies, a random lottery will be conducted among those in that ranking
- ▶ 50% admitted by random lottery
- Check student email regularly
 - Final status of eligibility will be sent via email only
