ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN LOS ANGELES COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT AND ALBANY STATE UNIVERSITY REVISED, MARCH 2008

LOS ANGELES COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT (LACCD), consisting of nine (9) participating colleges, to wit, Los Angeles City College (LACC), East Los Angeles College (ELAC), Los Angeles Harbor College (LAHC), Los Angeles Mission College (LAMC), Los Angeles Pierce College (LAPC), Los Angeles Southwest College (LASC), Los Angeles Trade Technical College (LATTC), Los Angeles Valley College (LAVC), and West Los Angeles College (WLAC), hereby enters into this Articulation Agreement with ALBANY STATE UNIVERSITY (ASU) as follows:

Purpose:

LACCD and ASU are entering into an agreement to promote student mobility, to avoid duplication of course work and to facilitate the transition from a two year institution to a four year degree program. This agreement specifically authorizes ASU's acceptance of credit hours in the core curriculum from LACCD institutions in satisfaction of any degree program offered at ASU under the conditions stated herein.

Term:

This agreement commenced as of June 2008. Terms of this agreement will continue in effect for three (3) years from the signature dates. Either party may terminate this agreement upon giving written notice to the other party. Such notice must be given one full semester/quarter prior to the agreement being cancelled.

Conditions:

The attachment affixed to this Articulation Agreement, and incorporated herein by reference, contains a list of course substitutions and core requirements that must be met to obtain course credit from ASU for coursework completed at LACCD institutions. Courses not transferable from LACCD must be taken at ASU. LACCD courses that have no direct ASU counterpart will be accepted as general electives, up to twelve (12) credit hours. A grade of "C" or better is needed for all transfer courses that fall within the student's major discipline (degree program). Additional requirements of specific degree programs at ASU, as well as graduation requirements mandated by ASU and the University System of Georgia (Regents' Test, Major Field Achievement Test, etc.), are not included in the attachment and must be satisfied once a student chooses a particular degree program.

ASU may request documentation of the credentials of any LACCD faculty teaching courses which are accepted as transfer credit. To ensure

that courses are comparable in content, either college, at their election, may conduct an annual review of course syllabi for all courses approved for substitution.

Both LACCD and ASU affirm that they are institutions in good standing and that they possess degree-granting authority conferred by their accrediting agencies. Failure to maintain accreditation shall automatically void this Articulation Agreement.
