

Transfer Admission Guarantee Between the Los Angeles Community College District and Savannah State University

The attached document establishes a transfer admission guarantee between the Los Angeles Community College District (LACCD) and Savannah State University. In entering into this agreement, LACCD and Savannah State University have several goals, which include:

- Assisting prospective transfer students in the LACCD to progress toward their baccalaureate degree goals;
- Enabling LACCD students to follow a course of study that allows them to begin upper division course work immediately upon transfer;
- Assuring LACCD students that if they follow the terms of their approved transfer agreement, they are guaranteed admission to Savannah State University in the term agreed upon;
- Facilitating cooperation between the counseling offices and the transfer centers at their respective institutions.

Savannah State University in partnership with the LACCD has developed transfer procedures to implement this guarantee. To assure that the transfer admission guarantee remains current, the respective parties to this understanding agree to consult regularly on issues of enrollment, articulation, and program change. The goal of both LACCD and Savannah State University is to minimize barriers to transfer and to increase the number of students who successfully complete the baccalaureate degree.

Articulation Agreement Between Savannah State University and Los Angeles Community College District

I. General Provisions of the Agreement

The following information outlines an agreement between Los Angeles Community College District and Savannah State University. This agreement will be reviewed every two years or as needed by Los Angeles Community College District (LACCD) and Savannah State University.

- This Agreement will be in effect starting Fall Semester 2008. LACCD students who fulfill the criteria listed below will be admitted to Savannah State University.
- The Agreement assures general admission to Savannah State University but not necessarily admission to a specific major.

II. Conditions of the Articulation Agreement

To qualify for this Articulation Agreement, students must:

- Apply for admission to SSU during the application filing period for the fall in which they wish to transfer.
- Earn a C or better in Area A: ENGL 101, and ENGL 102 or 103; MATH 245, 240 or 241 and 260.
- Earn a C or better in Area B: HIST 2, and HIST 5, SPEH 101
- Earn a C or better in Area C: HUMN 30, 31 or 60, ART104, MUSC 101, THER 100, ENGL 203, 204
- Earn a C or better in Area D: CO SCI 101; PHYED 228, 630 102
- Complete the last 30 of their 60 or more SSU transferable units at Los Angeles Community College District.
- Earn a cumulative 2.0 grade point average in SSU transferable courses by the end of the current fall semester and a 2.0 GPA or higher in all courses prior to transfer.

More specifically,

- Applicants admitted under this agreement must have successfully completed the Associate or Arts or Associate of Science Degree program of study.
- Applicants pursuing degrees in specialized degree programs at Savannah State University (Mass Communications, College of Business Administration, Engineering Technology, and Social Work) must meet the requirements established by the respective accrediting professional organization. Applicants and or advisors should contact the stated Colleges and / or disciplines for specific information.
- Applicants must satisfy the state of Georgia's examination requirements in American Government and American History courses. That is, applicants are required to have a general knowledge of Georgia's History and Government.
- Applicants should register to take the Board of Regents Examination during the first semester of enrollment; the Regents consist of reading and writing exams. All students must pass said examination in order to graduate from any college or university within the University of System of Georgia.
- Including the Associate Degree, applicants must obtain a minimum of 120 credit hours to graduate from Savannah State University.

III Evaluation and Review

Los Angeles Community College Districtand and Savannah State University will form an oversight committee charged with evaluation and review of this agreement. This committee will make modification as needed.

Terms of the transfer agreement:

- 1. Apply for admission to SSU during the application filing period for fall in which you wish to transfer.
- 2. Students are required to earn a "C" or better in Areas A and E and all areas in pursuant to an Associates degree.
- 3. Complete the <u>last</u> 30 of your 60 or more SSU transferable units at LACCD; and
- 4. Earn a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 in all SSU transferable courses work by the end of the current fall semester and a 2.0 GPA or higher in all courses prior to transfer.
- 5. Applicants pursuing degrees in specialized accredited degree programs (Mass Communications, College of Business Administration, Engineering Technology, and Social Work) must meet the requirements by the respective accrediting professional organization. Applicants and or advisors should contact the aforementioned Colleges and/or disciplines for specific information.
- 6. Applicants admitted under this admission agreement must have successfully completed the Associate of Arts and/or Associate of Science Degree program of study.
- 7. Including the Associate Degree, applicants must obtain a minimum of 120 credit hours to graduate from Savannah State University.

Area F: Courses related to the major grades of C or better accepted.

Regents Test: All students are required to pass the reading and writing portions of the Regents Test.
