
5-Year Award Trend

In the academic year 2023-24, Harbor College awarded 1,915 Associate and Transfer degrees, 757 credit certificates, and 43 non-credit certificates.





Credit Degrees and Certificates

Associate in Arts/Science Degrees (AA/AS): These degrees are intended for students who wish to acquire knowledge, skills, and competencies required for employment in a field related to the major or for transfer to a four-year institution. These degrees are not specifically designed to meet transfer requirements.

Associate in Arts/Science Degrees for Transfer (AAT/AST/STU): These degrees are intended for students planning to transfer into a Bachelor of Arts/Science program in the same or related subject at a California State University (CSU), guaranteeing admission to the system (but not to a specific campus), and priority consideration for admission to the equivalent CSU program.

Certificates of Achievement (CA): These credit certificates are intended for students who wish to acquire knowledge, skills, and competencies required for employment in a field related to the major. Most require a minimum of 16 units, although some may require as few as 8 units.

Skills Certificates (SC): These credit certificates are intended for students who wish to build skills for personal development or those that may be applicable to employment in a field related to the major. Skills Certificates do not appear on student transcripts.

Non-Credit Certificates

Certificates of Completion/Competency (CN/CY): These certificates prepare students for success in college. Students will obtain the basic skills needed to successfully transition to college classes and start working towards their certificate, degree, or transfer goals.

Award Offerings

LAHC offered a variety of degrees and certificates in 2023-2024: 57 degrees (AA/AS/AAT/ AST/STU), 49 credit certificates, and 22 non-credit certificates.




Figure 5. 2 LAHC Degrees and Certificates Offered, 2023-24

Degrees and Certificates Awarded

By Award Type

Associate in Arts degrees make up at least half of awards conferred in the last five years. In 2023-24, over 2,700 degrees and certificates were awarded to 887 students. Females made up a majority (65.5%) of award recipients. The proportion of students under 20 years old earning an award has been growing.
