Vision 2030: LAHC 2024 Report

Vision 2030 is a collaborative action plan developed by the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office to provide focus, equity, and strategic direction for California's 73 community college districts and 116 colleges. Together, the California Community Colleges form the largest system of postsecondary education in the United States, serving over two million students. As a primary engine of social and economic mobility, the colleges play a vital role in helping the state achieve its ambitious goal: ensuring that 70% of working-age Californians attain a postsecondary degree or certificate by 2030.

Vision 2030 offers a clear roadmap for colleges to implement data-informed, studentcentered strategies that expand equitable access, support, and success. It emphasizes community engagement, addresses workforce development priorities across key industry sectors, and supports seamless student pathways from ninth grade through bachelor's degree completion. The plan also responds to emerging challenges and opportunities, including the rise of generative AI, climate change, and the need to modernize data systems for more effective student support.

There are three Vision 2030 goals and their associated outcomes. The goals and outcomes encompass equity in success, access, and support. The measurable outcomes will be critical to track progress and ensure continuous improvement.

Goal 1: Equity in Success

Ensure the academic and career success of all Californians who are current and prospective California community college students. The outcomes of this goal include: increase with equity, the number of students who complete a meaningful educational outcome, ultimately earn a bachelor's degree, earn an Associate Degree for Transfer, earn a community college baccalaureate, transfer to California State University (CSU) or University of California (UC) or non-profit private/independent four-year institutions, and the number of students who earn a living wage.

Goal 2: Equity in Access

Broaden the opportunities for all Californians to participate in higher education by starting or continuing their higher education at a California community college. The outcome of this goal is to increase with equity, the number of students attending a California community college, with particular emphasis on the number of underserved Californians. **Goal 3: Equity in Support**

Partner with other systems, agencies, institutions and community-based organizations to provide students the academic, financial and social supports necessary to thrive by taking education opportunities and the accompanying support to Californians. The outcomes of this goal include: increase with equity, the number of students receiving state and federal aid; and, decrease with equity, the number of units in excess of 60 units for the Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT).

A key component of Vision 2030 is the DataVista website, an open-access platform developed by the Chancellor's Office in partnership with WestEd. DataVista provides comprehensive metrics on student success in California Community Colleges and Adult Education. The platform is continuously updated with new data and user support tools to ensure transparency and usability for educators, policymakers, and the public.





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
