Eligibility to Apply

- Anatomy 001, Physiology 001, and Microbiology 020 with a "C" or better and a combined Science GPA of 2.5 or greater with no more than 1 repeat of substandard grade (D, F) within the 3 science courses
- English C1000 (101) with a "C" or better
- Mathematical Concepts & Quantitative Reasoning (LACCD area 2)
- Psychology C1000 (001) and Psychology 041 with a "C" or better
- **Cumulative GPA of 2.5** or greater
